**Toilet twinning** 2.6 billion people – that's 40% of the world's population – does not have somewhere safe, clean and hygienic to go to the loo. The human impact of this scandalous statistic is enormous: nearly one in five child deaths each year is due to diarrhoea. This can be changed by twinning toilets. For people in poor communities, a hole in the ground is quite literally a life saver – protecting women from the risk of attack as they find somewhere private to squat, and shielding children from preventable diarrhoea diseases. VEC has decided to twin our toilets and you will see picture of these in the toilets.
