Toilet twinning: We have decided to twin our toilets as 2.6 billion people, that's 40% of the world's population – does not have somewhere safe, clean and hygienic to go to the loo. The human impact of this scandalous statistic is enormous: nearly one in five child deaths each year is due to diarrhoea. This can be changed by twinning toilets. For people in poor communities, a hole in the ground is quite literally a life saver – protecting women from the risk of attack as they find somewhere private to squat, and shielding children from preventable diarrhoea diseases.
