

## **FAMILY NEWS**

**Iain Hemington and his sister Jane** have given the latest update on their mother below, please keep praying.

The doctors have been little more positive. Mum is more relaxed which is an indication that the pain medication is having an effect. The chest infection is under control with antibiotics and the doctors have said she is stable. Her heart rate is still worryingly high - either as a side effect of the medication or due to dehydration. Iain says the bruising on her face has gone down. She is still very drowsy and unresponsive - also probably due to the medication. The next step is to put a nerve block in around her ribs to block the pain there. While this is helpful, it won't affect her pelvic and back pain so she will probably still need the opiates. The doctors are not going to operate on her back or pelvis but will wait for the bones to heal naturally.
