Passage: 1 Samuel 20:30-42

Last Sunday we looked at 1 Samuel 20 and saw the contrasted lives of Saul, David and Johnathan. Saul unlike David and Johnathan tried in vain to fill the void of insecurity and lack of identity by seeking his own kingship, which ultimately led to his own destruction. Saul grows in rage and hatred, David and Johnathan in God's favour and love. We all have been created to have a relationship with God and from that foundational Rock we operate through all life brings, both good and bad. Below are a few foundational truths to build our lives upon.

Philippians 4:11-13 *"I am not saying this because I am in need, for I have learned to be content whatever the circumstances. I know what it is to be in need, and I know what it is to have plenty. I have learned the secret of being content in any and every situation, whether well fed or hungry, whether living in plenty or in want. I can do all this through him who gives me strength".*

Ephesians 2:8 *"For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith – and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God".*

Ephesians 1:3-5 *"Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in the heavenly realms with every spiritual blessing in Christ. For he chose us in him before the creation of the world to be holy and blameless in his sight. **In love he predestined us for adoption** to sonship through Jesus Christ, **in accordance with his pleasure and will**".*

1 Corinthians 15:10 *"But by the grace of God I am what I am, and his grace to me was not without effect".* **1 Peter 1:1-3** *"To God's elect (you), who have been **chosen according to the foreknowledge of God the Father**, through the sanctifying work of the Spirit, to be obedient to Jesus Christ and sprinkled with his blood: Grace and peace be yours in abundance".*

Philippians 3:12 *"Not that I have already obtained all this, or have already arrived at my goal, but I press on to take hold of that for which Christ Jesus took hold of me".*

Ephesians 3:17-19 *"And I pray that you, being rooted and established in love, may have power, together with all the Lord's holy people, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, and to know this love that surpasses knowledge – that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God".*
