Passage: 2 Samuel 1: 1-17

Last Sunday through 2 Samuel 1, *David Hears of Saul's Death*, we looked at both the fear of the Lord and God's heart to those who don't know Him.

Not only did David mourn Saul's death but also asked the Amalekite in Verse 14 "*Why weren't you afraid to lift your hand to destroy the Lord's anointed?*". David's fear of laying hands on the Lord's anointed emanates from his healthy fear of the Lord – "Serve the LORD with fear, and rejoice with trembling", Psalm 2:11.

Jesus said in Luke 12:4-6 "*I tell you, my friends, do not be afraid of those who kill the body and after that can do no more. But I will show you whom you should fear: fear him who, after your body has been killed, has authority to throw you into hell. Yes, I tell you, fear him*".

David the man after God's own heart, mourned the death of Saul likewise God's heart is for all to be saved. Saved from what His coming wrath, there can be no salvation without repentance and grace leads us to repentance. God's nature is never changing and His holiness will fill the Earth, sin cannot dwell in presence, He hates sin but loves us and has provided a means of escape.
